



Author Guidelines for the Cloud Report

The Cloud Report aims to shed light on the subject "cloud". We evaluate the various cloud solutions, the different propositions and providers, and the technologies towards and inside cloud. Of course, we also cover topics such as costs, security, development directions and visions of the future, what can the cloud enable? We investigate software, hardware, as well as important questions from customers.

A topic can be covered in an overview or in depth. We will consider both directions.

For the text

- The text should not exceed an approximate length of 5 typed pages (about 2,500 words or 12,500 characters) as it should also be easy to read online.
- The contributions should be submitted in English.
- The article should be summarized in a short abstract (3-5 sentences).
- The title of the article should give a concise description of its content. If required, a subtitle is also possible.
- All the authors will be mentioned together with the personal data of the author or the company of the author, if he / she wants to include it. On request even a short CV can be added to the article. We would also like to attach a picture of the author and a logo of the company.
- If necessary or possible, the contribution may be subdivided by meaningful subheadings.
- Additional or explanatory illustrations and graphics are expressly desired. Preferably the text and image should be balanced against each other. Much information can therefore be conveyed via the illustrations or graphics and appropriately detailed captions.
- Please address the illustrations with direct reference to the text so that they can be clearly assigned, e.g. by superscript numbering in the text. For images already published, a reprint permission must be obtained, and the source must be indicated in the caption.
- All sources will be mentioned in full. For all texts the copyrights are valid.

Manuscript submission

Please submit your manuscript via presse@cloudical.io or an exchange server via this e-mail address. For the manuscript file all common word processing programs are allowed. In any case, the text is published by the publisher in a layout program. To avoid errors, the text should contain as few formatting as possible. In particular, hyphenation, special characters and unnecessary tabs should be avoided. Please save the images in separate files.

Checklist

Once completed, the manuscript should be checked again using the following checklist:

1. Title (if used, subtitles)
2. Author(s), if applicable company and e-mail address
3. Text (with references to illustrations, tables and literature)
4. Bibliography
5. Captions
6. Images and tables
7. Portrait photo of the author(s), logo of the company

General conditions

The publisher reserves the right to edit the text, to correct the spelling and grammar and, if necessary, to adapt the text to be printed.

After publication, the author will receive a link to their article, which they may use to post or repost on their homepage. If desired, the author may also receive a printed copy of The Cloud Report.

By submitting the manuscript, the author gives the publisher the right to publish, print and distribute the article online. The publisher also receives the right for reprints and translations into other languages.

We publish The Cloud Report freely accessible on the Internet, therefore there is no direct compensation from the author. If the article is sponsored by a customer, the author receives 50% of the sum. Advertisement and sponsoring conditions can be found in the media kit.

The abstract will appear on the homepage of The Cloud Report and on social networks. It serves as an eye-catcher and should create interest in the article. The author may use it freely, but always add the link to the article.

The author is free to publish their article in other contexts or journals. However, The Cloud Report must be announced or linked to as a place of first publication. If the article has already been published in another magazine or another website, we ask for permission to print and mention the first publication in the source references.
